Adams Funeral Home and Cremation Services Ltd. is independently family owned and operated by Doug and Lorie Adams. It is our goal to exceed the services offered by other funeral service providers in the area. Every life lived has an impact on others. That impact should be honored in a meaningful way. We respect each and every family's request.

Our Facilities

Our funeral home offers a relaxing atmosphere for the families we serve, the friends and relatives that come to visit during the public visitation and services. Our convenient location, large parking lot and warm inviting interior make the Adams Funeral Home and Cremation Services Ltd. a unique funeral provider in Barrie and surrounding area. From the time you enter the doors of the funeral home you will be greeted and treated with warmth and respect. It is an honor for our staff to assist every person who visits the funeral home.

The visitation suites provide the comfort and atmosphere of a family living room and yet provide the accommodation of large gatherings. The chapel provides ample room for any size funeral or memorial gathering, along with a family suite off of the chapel area. We hope that our tasteful decorating and comfortable furniture will make the experience of visiting our funeral home less stressful. With large windows, natural lighting will flood into the common areas and provide a soothing feeling and help reduce the stress of visiting a funeral home.

Our building is designed to provide barrier free access for all who visit. We also offer Hearing Assist for the hearing impaired. The main floor is level off of the parking lot with access to the second floor by elevator. All door ways are wide enough to accommodate wheelchairs and motorized scooters.

Services Performed by the Funeral Home

Professional Consultation - Includes the initial conference with family members where we listen, understand and take direction with respect to the particular funeral needs. The Funeral Director will also offer advice and direction with respect to practices and procedures during this meeting, and in the days that follow. Additionally, information required for vital statistics, cemeteries, crematoriums, clergy, composition of newspaper or website announcements, and personalized memorial supplies will be gathered. Families will be introduced to the full spectrum of the Funeral Home's services and supplies, the itemized cost of each, and invited to make choices they believe best represent their needs and beliefs.

Co-ordinating Rites and Ceremonies - Co-ordinating with the hospital or other place of death for the transfer of the remains into the funeral home's care. Organizing with clergy, musicians, cemetery and/or crematorium for final disposition, reception facilitator, coroner and other necessary contacts; preparing and placing death notices (when required); overseeing all other staff functions necessary to implement the arrangements as discussed.

Documentation - This service required by the Funeral Directors and office staff includes, completing the Statement of Death Form for the Registration Office along with completing the Cremation Application for the crematorium. This service also includes the notification of government agencies on behalf of the family and assistance with Canada Pension Plan forms and filing. Included are the provision of Proof of Death Certificates for estate settlement and the provision of records to clergy and cemeteries for their proper record keeping. Processing of memorial donations and distribution of donations to appropriate charity is also included with this service. The services of all administrative staff including bookkeeping, care and maintenance of all records is also included.

Transport Remains from Place of Death - The transfer of the deceased from the place of death (within a 40 km radius) to the funeral home. When the death occurs beyond 40 km of the funeral home a mileage charge will be applied for the additional distance. This service is provided 24 hours, seven days a week and includes a specialized vehicle with sanitized equipment, clean linens, personal protection for each staff member and when necessary the services of two staff members to perform the transfer with dignity.

Basic Preparation of Remains - This is a required service for all families. This includes primary sanitation, placing the deceased in a clean shroud or dressing the deceased (if practical) and placing the deceased in the casket selected. Depending on the cause of death, the completion of this procedure would, in most but not necessarily all circumstances, be sufficient to allow for an individual to identify a family member, a practice not required by recommended.

Embalming of Remains – In addition to the process noted above, embalming offers the further disinfection and preservation of a deceased person. This also includes light cosmetics (if necessary) and hair dressing services. While embalming is not required by law we make the following four suggestions as to when embalming should take place:

- If the funeral or any public gathering is to be held beyond 24 hours after the time of death;
- If there is to be either a private or public viewing of the deceased;
- If circumstances such as a springtime or delayed interment exists;
- If the deceased is to be repatriated to a distant destination using public transport, international carriers often require embalming as a prerequisite for travel.

Staff Services for Visitation - The services provided by the staff including preparation for visitation hours at the funeral home, the arrangement of casket or urn and flowers in a visitation suite. The funeral director and assistants will supervise the visitation hours welcoming guests on the family's behalf, keeping the premises clean and welcoming, receiving and accepting memorial donations, and cleaning and securing the visitation areas after family and guests have left. When necessary, the funeral director and assistant will oversee fraternal or lodge services.

Staff Services for Ceremony – On Site - The preparation for the funeral or memorial service including the arrangement of the casket or urn and flowers in the funeral home chapel. Other responsibilities of the Funeral Director and assistants include care and instruction of the officiant, coordination of music, musicians or video tributes, supervising seating arrangements, briefing pallbearers of their duties and generally being available to respond to any need or unexpected occurrence affecting the family or their guests. The services of a funeral director and assistants to conduct the funeral or memorial service and accept and place memorial donations and forward reconciled report to appropriate charities. Other services included are the care and delivery of flowers to the cemetery and or other locations.

Staff Services for Ceremony – Off Site - The preparation by the Funeral Director and Funeral Director's Assistance for the Funeral or Memorial Service being held off site. Other responsibilities of the Funeral Director and assistants include care and instruction, coordination of music, musicians or video tributes, supervising seating arrangements, briefing pallbearers of their duties and generally being available to respond to any need or unexpected occurrence affecting the family or their guests. The services of a funeral director and assistants to conduct the funeral or memorial service and accept and place memorial donations and forward reconciled report to appropriate charities. Other services included are the care and delivery of flowers to the cemetery and or other locations.

Basic Facilities – This service includes 24-hour telephone coverage, staff being on call, maintenance of the building and parking lot, property tax and utilities of building, handling of biohazard waste as well as professional association fees. As well included in this service is the Ontario Board of Funeral Service Licensing Fee for each registered death and the licensing fee for each Licensed Funeral Director.

Facilities for Preparation – Embalm and Shelter of Remains – A specialized secured holding facility for the remains until visitation or transportation to the cemetery or crematorium. This facility is equipped with the required sanitation, ventilation, instruments and equipment for the holding of the remains. It is required to have appropriate safety equipment and be inspected annually by the local health unit.

Facilities for Visitation – The use of a room or area in the funeral home along with the furnishing for the purpose of public visitation times set by the family and Funeral Director. Included in this service is the use of a visitation suite, devotional equipment (if requested), flower stands, register book stand and refreshment counter. The funeral home is fully accessible with an elevator and features Hearing Assist for the hearing impaired. The building is fully secured and is monitored 24 hours for peace of mind.

Facilities for Ceremony – The use of the funeral home building and furnishing for the purpose of a public ceremony. This provides the use of the Chapel or other suitable area of the funeral home along with the furnishings which include the chapel seating, lectern, electric keyboard (for service music) and sound system along with Hearing Assist for the hearing impaired. The use of this facility is determined during the arrangement conference and a time of use is set at that meeting.

Equipment for Ceremonies Held Off Site – In order for a ceremony to be held off site equipment will be required. This equipment will need to be placed into a vehicle and transported to a church or facility where the ceremony is to be held. This service includes the required vehicles, staff, flower stands, register book stand, reserved seat signs and the appropriate staff back at the funeral home for proper coverage of the building.

General Duty/Administrative/Lead Car – This vehicle is required for transportation to the Registration Office for the registration of a death and the Coroner's office for the completion of a Cremation Form when cremation is the final disposition. The use of this car would include the following: leading of the funeral procession to the funeral service at a church, leading a funeral procession from the place of a funeral service or delivery of cremated remains to a cemetery for interment. Any distance beyond 40 km radius of the funeral home may result in an additional charge.

Funeral Coach – The use of this specialized car within a 40 km radius and for a period of three hours includes the transportation of the deceased from the funeral home to the cemetery or crematorium, or from the funeral home to the church or other appropriate facility for the funeral and then to the cemetery or crematorium. Any distance beyond 40 km radius of the funeral home or time over three hours may result in an additional charge.

Service Vehicle – The use of this vehicle includes the transportation of the deceased to the cemetery or crematorium within a 40 km radius of the funeral home when the use of a funeral coach is not requested. This may also be a vehicle used to transport equipment from the funeral home to an offsite facility for visitation or ceremony. Any distance beyond 40 km of the funeral home is subject to additional mileage charges.

Personal Memorial Supplies (Stationery Package) – The personalization of a guest register book, the provision of 50 memorial cards (additional memorial cards are available at a cost of \$25.00 per 50) and 25 acknowledgement cards. Additional acknowledgement cards are available at a cost of \$25.00 per box of 25 cards. This package does not include an Order of Service for the funeral service.

Family/pallbearers Car (Optional Vehicle) – The use of this car may include: the transportation of the family to the funeral home, church, or other appropriate facility where the Funeral or Memorial Service will be held. This service also includes the transportation for family or pallbearers to the cemetery or crematorium.

Mileage – An additional fee for all funeral home vehicles which travel outside of a 40km radius of the funeral home. This rate is charged per kilometer.

After Funeral Reception Facility (Optional) – This service includes the use of the funeral home reception facilities for a reception after the Funeral Service or Memorial Service. The reception area may be used for a luncheon with catering arranged by the funeral home or the family. Tea, coffee, cups, saucers, plates, napkins and linens along with a hostess are provided by the funeral home.
